

DANE COUNTY FAIR HORSE & PONY EXHIBITOR BEHAVIOR POLICY

As a representative of the Dane County Fair Horse & Pony Department, exhibitors are expected to adhere to behavior expectations such as, but not limited to:

- No possession or consumption of alcohol, tobacco or other illegal substances.
- No abuse or neglect of an animal.
- No theft, vandalism or hazing.
- No willful disrespect for others, use of profane language or behavior unbecoming to a Dane County Fair Exhibitor who should serve as a role model at this event.

Any member violating the above rules will be subject to any or all of the following consequences:

1. Immediate dismissal of the offending exhibitor from Department 6 of the Dane Co Fair this year.
2. The dismissed exhibitor (if a 4H member) may be ineligible to show at State 4H Horse Expo.
3. Transportation of the animal to home is the expense of the parents of the dismissed exhibitor.
4. Damage to any public or private property beyond its normal use is at the expense of the exhibitor.

Interpretation of major rule violations above and beyond those listed above are at the discretion of the Dane County Fair Horse & Pony Superintendents.

I agree to abide by this policy and all Dane County Fairground rules. I understand it is a privilege to show at the Dane County Fair and this privilege will be revoked by failure to abide by this policy.
